### National Police Certificate (NPC)

#### **Explanatory Notes**

Legislation in various states and territories and the Commonwealth of Australia restricts the information that can be disclosed about a person's court outcomes unless specific exemptions apply under law. Legislative exemptions can include specific types of employment, voluntary work, licenses or membership of a profession. The information provided will include all disclosable convictions or findings of guilt by a court.

A NPC may also include supplementary person history information which could include outstanding matters such as warrants or pending court cases. It is important to note that, until such a time as an outstanding matter has been determined by a court it cannot be regarded as a finding of guilt.
